IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL FACILITIES SUBJECT TO THE AIR TOXICS SURCHARGE

(P.L. 2004, c.51)

Facilities that have submitted a 2002 Release and Pollution Prevention Report (RPPR), relating to 2002 emissions, should have received their Air Toxics Surcharge Return Assessment outlining their surcharge obligation. The pre-printed return reflects the total emissions for each of the three categories as was reported on the RPPR to the DEP and a total Surcharge due.

PLEASE NOTE: The DUE DATE for the Air Toxics Surcharge Return Assessment (Form ATX-100) with payment relating to emissions reported on the RPPR for the 2002 calendar year HAS BEEN EXTENDED TO MAY 15, 2005.
