

## Direct Assistance for ITIN Holders

## Coming This November 2022!

The Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN) Direct Assistance Program provides a one-time financial benefit to income-eligible New Jersey residents who file income taxes using an ITIN.

## WHO IS ELIGIBLE?



Individuals who filed 2021 income taxes using an ITIN



Have an annual household income below 200% of the federal poverty level



Eligible members also include other ITIN holders listed on your tax return

1	\$25,760
2	\$34,840
3	\$43,920
4	\$53,000
5	\$62,080
6	\$71,160

8	\$89,320

## **OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION:**

- The benefit amount is \$500 per eligible member in the household
- You do not need to apply for this program. If your tax filing meets the eligibility requirements, you will automatically be mailed a check from the state of New Jersey to the address that you used to file your 2021 taxes
- If you did not file a New Jersey tax return for 2021, you may be eligible based on your 2020 income tax return. The NJ Department of Treasury is sending you a letter notifying you that you may be eligible once you file your 2021 taxes (NJ- 1040). The deadline to file and still be eligible for this benefit is **April 15, 2023**
- This one-time benefit is not considered under the public charge rule or impact eligibility for public benefit programs such as Medicaid, SNAP or TANF
