## **Proof of Age or Disability Must Be Submitted With Application**

**Age 65 or Older.** If you (or your spouse) indicated at Line 4a that you were 65 or older on December 31, 2004, you must submit proof of age with your application. Examples of acceptable documentation include copies of the following:

- Birth Certificate
- Driver's License
- Church Records

Receiving Federal Social Security Disability Benefits. If you (or your spouse) were under 65 and indicated at Lines 4a and 4b that you were receiving Federal Social Security Disability Benefits on December 31, 2004, and you (or your spouse) continued to receive benefits through December 31, 2005, you must submit with your application a copy of the Social Security Award Letter indicating that you (or your spouse) were receiving benefits based on your own social security number. **Note:** If your marital status is "Married," the same person who was receiving disability benefits on December 31, 2004, must still be receiving benefits on December 31, 2005.
